Mayor Robert "BJ" Berlin brought the hearing to order at 6:55 p.m. and read the hearing notice aloud:

CITY OF ROBERTS, IDAHO

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Roberts, Idaho, will hold a public hearing in the City Council Chambers of the Roberts City Building, 647 North 2872 East, Roberts, Idaho, on April 14, 2026, at 6:55 p.m., to consider the adoption of an ordinance entitled:

“An Ordinance of the City of Roberts Amending Ordinance No. 498 (6/2015) to Require Permits for Site Improvements; Require Visible Address Numbers for All New Construction; Adopt the Idaho Standards for Public Works Construction; Revise Penalties for Violations; and Providing for Ratification, Severability, and an Effective Date.”

The proposed ordinance would require permits for all site improvements, including driveways, sidewalks, patios, decks, retaining walls, grading, or other flat work that may affect public safety, drainage, or municipal infrastructure; require all newly constructed residential and commercial buildings to display visible address numbers from the street consistent with the adopted Fire Code; adopt the Idaho Standards for Public Works Construction (ISPWC) as the official standards for design, construction, and materials of all public works projects within the City; and revise penalties for violations to provide infractions for first and second offenses and misdemeanor penalties for subsequent offenses.

All interested persons are invited to attend the public hearing and provide oral or written comments. Copies of the proposed ordinance are available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk during regular business hours.

Mayor Berlin asked the Clerk if anyone had signed in to testify. Clerk said no one had signed in to speak.

Mayor Berlin opened the floor for favorable comments.

No testimony was given.


Mayor Berlin opened the floor for opposition comments.


No testimony was given.
