ORDINANCE NO. 2024-569

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2024 – SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$10,766,876.00 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSE AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF ROBERTS FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A SUFFICIENT TAX UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATIONS ARE MADE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROBERTS, JEFFERSON COUNTY, IDAHO

Section 1: That the sum of \$10,766,876.00 be and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Roberts, Jefferson County, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024.

Section 2: The objects and purposes for which appropriations are made and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

Section 3: That a General Tax Levy on all taxable property within the City of Roberts be levied in amount allowed by law for the general purposes for said City, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024.

Section 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Jefferson Star, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Roberts, and the official newspaper of said City.

Mayor Berlin asked if there were any questions.

Gale Scrivner, 2859 E 647 N, asked what grants were included in the \$9,990,000.

Mayor Berlin answered, \$220,000 for sidewalks, \$4,700,000 for emergent contaminants, \$800,000 for water study, and \$3,500,000 for wastewater collection project. Mayor Berlin also explained that there may be more grants and so the number is a bit higher to accommodate any further awards that may happen.
